Our core services include clinical assessments, therapeutic interventions, mental health training, and clinical supervision, with a proven track record supporting individuals, universities, schools, and public-sector programs. We offer end-to-end support, guiding clients through their full care journey. 



Our People



This structure enables consistent service delivery, reduced access times, and strong alignment with quality and safety standards. We are also committed to workforce development through the supervision and training of provisional and early-career psychologists, contributing to the long-term sustainability of the mental health sector.

Success Stories

Psychology In Aged Care Program

Lifespan Health was awarded the tender to deliver the Psychology in Aged Care program (\$665,000 annually; May 2019 - Sep 2024), with Dr Diane Corser as the consultant and program developer. Our team of psychologists delivered individual and group psychological therapies across 32 residential aged care facilities in the Sunshine Coast and Gympie region, while also providing staff training to strengthen capacity in recognising and responding to residents' mental health needs. We met all contractual KPIs, built strong networks with aged care providers, hospitals, and allied health services, and contributed to workforce growth through student placements, training, and supervision. When COVID-19 restrictions limited access to facilities, we adapted quickly by implementing digital solutions and training staff to support residents via telehealth, before successfully advocating for the return of essential face-to-face services.

Low Intensity and Psychological Therapies for Underserviced and Hard to Reach Groups

Lifespan Health delivered individual psychology services within clinic and via telehealth for the Gympie community (Nov 2023 - Sep 2024), responding to high regional demand in an area with significant mental health needs and limited psychology workforce. We successfully engaged GPs and NGOs to reach priority groups including First Nations people, LGBTQI+ communities, and those experiencing financial disadvantage. Clients were triaged to clinicians best suited to their needs, with services spanning low-intensity parenting programs through to complex and severe presentations. Despite high demand, Lifespan Health maintained equity of access through a priority triage system, well-trained administrative support, and time-limited care models, while operating within budget. We built workforce capability by training eight provisional psychologists to full registration, and ensured continuity of care by collaborating with other agencies and sourcing alternative funding when program allocations were exhausted.
